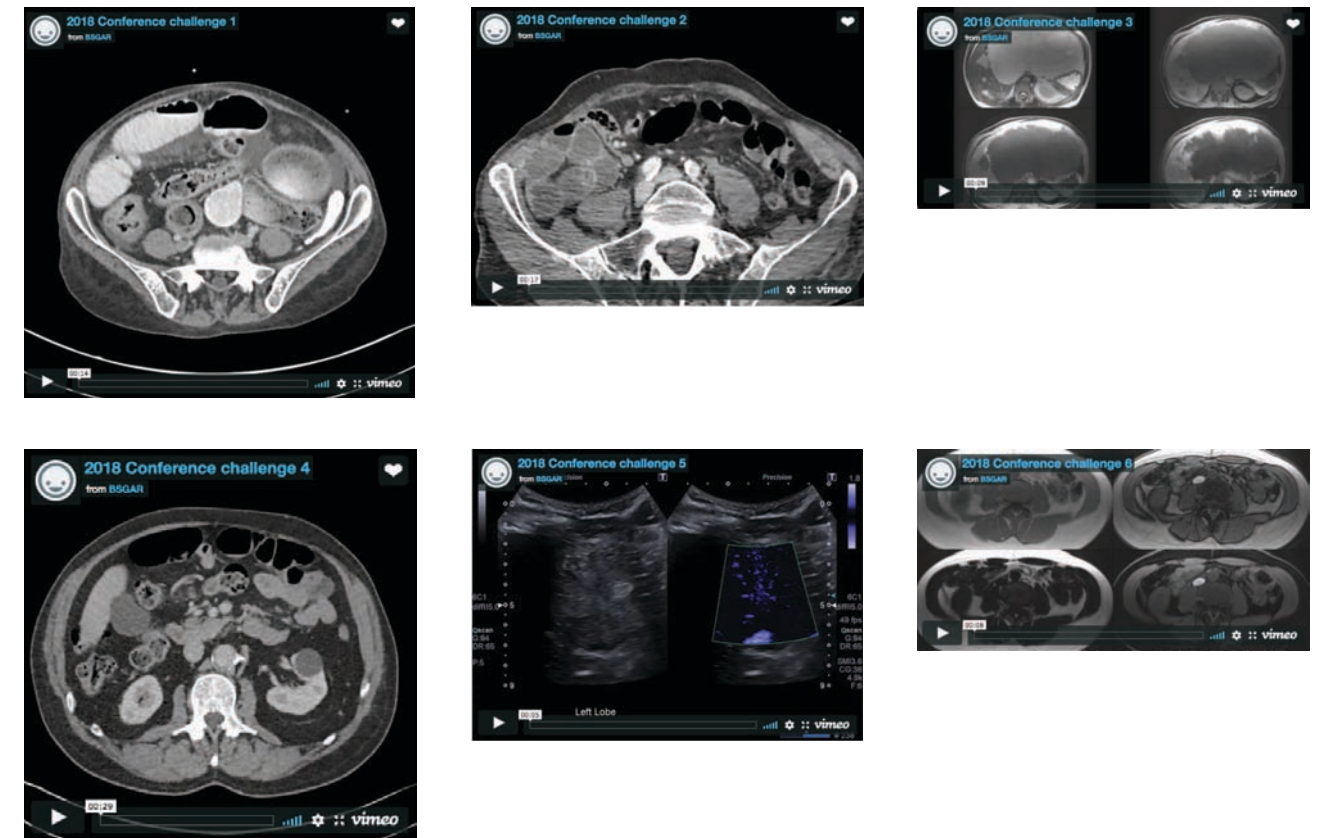
## ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

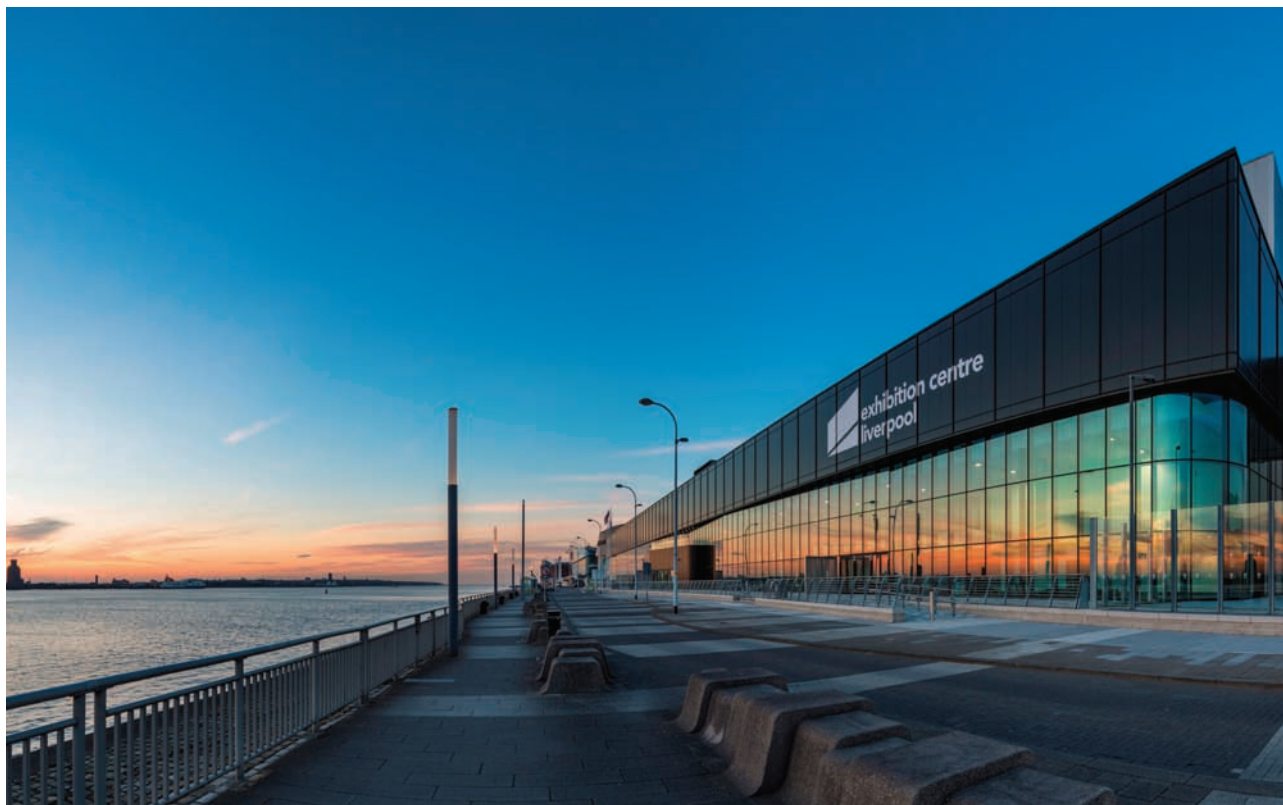
