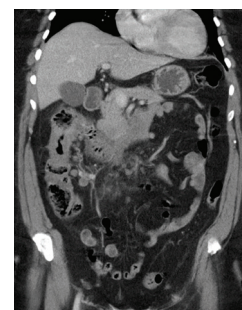
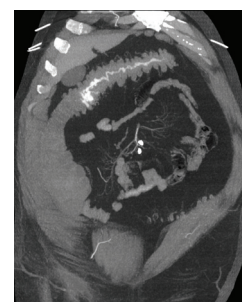
Attendees will sit in pairs at iMac workstations running Osirix viewing software. The day alternates between short lectures and longer **"hands-on"** case review sessions during which delegates will have the opportunity to review cases while faculty assist and discuss image interpretation. During the day you will review at least thirty examinations covering a wide range of emergency findings. The short lectures include **bowel obstruction, PPI (peritonitis, perforation, ischaemia), haemorrhage, trauma and post-op shambles.**

The faculty has extensive experience of emergency abdominal CT and have been selected for their highly-rated teaching skills and approachability.

Questions and discussion are encouraged through the whole of the day.

Multi-Parametric Imaging of the Prostate Workshop

The prostate workshop will take place in the Mac Lab at University Hospital Aintree for a maximum of 40 delegates. Each delegate will sit at an iMac workstation running Osirix viewing software.

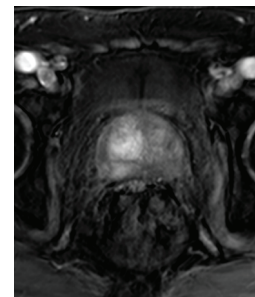
The day will include short lectures, and **'hands-on'** case review sessions during which delegates will have the opportunity to review cases and score them using standardised reporting formats.
