There will be a focus on improving the clinical end user experience, interoperability standards, sharing radiology images across organisations, data migration, home reporting, the role of specialty systems, the role of information systems in moving towards a 7 day service and delivering real time bedside imaging to improve patient care. There will be a pre conference supplier showcase where suppliers will be demonstrating their systems and how they can support your organization to deliver digital imaging in practice.
