



RCR/BSGAR Travelling Professorship

Jointly with the RCR, we are establishing a RCR/BSGAR Travelling Professorship to highlight the role of gastrointestinal and abdominal radiology in the UK, to encourage best practice, and promote the subspecialty. We are looking for enthusiastic Consultant GI/Abdominal Radiologists who are passionate about educating colleagues and trainees.

The appointment is expected to be for 18-24 months. During this time, the RCR/BSGAR Travelling Professor will be expected to undertake 4-7 visits to training programmes in the UK to deliver formal lectures, undertake appropriate workshops, and/or small group teaching as part of each visit. There is funding of up to £5000 over the term to support costs related to delivering these commitments.

We will consider making a joint appointment, with shared responsibilities and budget. Please indicate if you would prefer a joint appointment on the application form.

How to Apply

This position is open to Consultant Radiologists who are current members of BSGAR.

1. An Application Form including the following information:
 - Your title and name, job title and institution.
 - A proposal outlining the planned format and subject material of the lectures, workshops and/or other teaching to be delivered; your specific expertise in the proposed subject material; and details of any teaching/lecturing experience. The total word limit for these three sections is 500 words.
 - Whether you would prefer to be considered for a joint appointment.
2. A letter of support from your Line Manager/Clinical Director

Deadline for applications is **Friday 31st May 2019**. Candidates may be required to attend an interview or give a brief presentation in June/July 2019, remotely or in person. The position is expected to commence in September 2019.
