He was Radiology Clinical Director in Papworth Hospital 2004-12 and President of the British Society of Thoracic Imaging 2009-13.

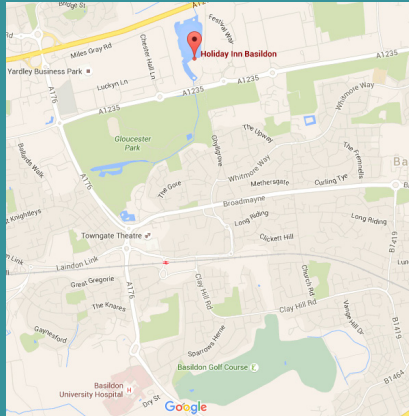
He has been a member of the BIR since 1998.
